

**PUBLIC OFFER AGREEMENT
for the Provision of Publishing Services in Academic Journals
of the Non-Profit Joint-Stock Company
“L.N. Gumilyov Eurasian National University”**

The Non-Profit Joint-Stock Company “L.N. Gumilyov Eurasian National University”, represented by the Chairman of the Management Board – Rector, E.B. Sydykov, acting on the basis of the Charter (approved by the Order of the Chairman of the State Property and Privatization Committee of the Ministry of Finance of the Republic of Kazakhstan dated May 12, 2020), hereinafter referred to as the “Company”, hereby addresses this Public Offer Agreement (hereinafter referred to as the “Agreement”) to the author(s) (hereinafter referred to as the “Author”) of a scholarly article who have expressed their willingness to submit an article through the Company’s electronic manuscript submission system for its academic journals.

1. General Provisions

1.1. This Agreement constitutes an official public offer of the Company to enter into an agreement for the provision of publishing services for the Company’s academic journals hosted on the website: <https://www.enu.kz/ru/page/science/scientific-publications>.

1.2. Acceptance, meaning the full and unconditional consent to properly perform the terms and conditions of this offer, shall be deemed to occur in the following form:

- submission of a manuscript by the Author through the Company’s electronic manuscript submission system for its academic journals.

1.3. By accepting this offer, the Author confirms that they have read, understood, and fully and unconditionally accepted all the terms and conditions set forth in this Agreement.

1.4. This Agreement does not require signing or stamping by the Author and the Company (hereinafter collectively referred to as the “Parties”) and shall remain legally valid and binding throughout the entire period of manuscript consideration.

1.5. The Company reserves the right to amend this Agreement. In this regard, the Author undertakes to regularly monitor any amendments to the Agreement published on the Company’s website. The revised terms of the public offer shall enter into force upon their publication on the website.

2. Subject of the Agreement

2.1. The Company undertakes to accept the manuscript and conduct a plagiarism check using licensed plagiarism detection systems and, subject to a

positive result and in accordance with the editorial policies of the Company's journals, to submit the manuscript for peer review, provided that the following conditions of this Agreement are met:

- the Author shall pay an advance fee equal to 20% of the article publication fee (twelve thousand Kazakhstani tenge) to cover the Publisher's expenses related to the use of licensed plagiarism detection systems, remuneration of reviewers, and the work of the journal editorial staff. In the event the manuscript is rejected by the journal editorial board, the advance fee shall be non-refundable;

- in the event of resubmission of the manuscript after revision based on the results of the assessment for compliance with the journal's formal requirements and peer review, the Author shall again pay 20% of the article publication fee. Only one resubmission after revision is permitted;

- the publication fee for one article accepted for publication by the journal editorial board shall be KZT 60,000 (sixty thousand Kazakhstani tenge).

3. Rights and Obligations of the Parties

3.1. The Company shall:

3.1.1. accept the manuscript for editorial consideration and conduct a plagiarism and originality check using licensed plagiarism detection systems;

3.1.2. upon a positive originality assessment, submit the manuscript for double-blind peer review to independent academic reviewers specializing in the relevant field of science;

3.1.3. upon a positive decision of the editorial board, publish the article in accordance with the established publication schedule.

3.2. The Company shall have the right to:

3.2.1. require the Author to duly and properly perform their obligations in accordance with this Agreement and the Company's internal rules and regulations, as well as to maintain proper, respectful, and professional conduct toward the Company's employees and the editorial boards of the academic journals;

3.2.2. request from the Author confirmation of payment of the journal's manuscript processing fees;

3.2.3. refuse further consideration of the manuscript in the following cases:

- if the manuscript fails to meet the minimum originality threshold in the licensed plagiarism detection system or if artificially generated text is detected;
- if negative peer review reports are received for the manuscript;
- if the manuscript does not comply with the technical and formatting requirements specified in the journal's editorial policy;
- if the Author fails to implement the revisions recommended by the reviewers;
- if facts of the use of external assistance from brokers and/or intermediary organizations (false authorship) are identified.

3.3. The Author shall:

3.3.1. familiarize themselves with the approved editorial policy of the journal;

3.3.2. submit an original scholarly work and, in the event of using materials authored by others, ensure that appropriate bibliographic citations or quotations are provided;

3.3.3. refrain from using external assistance from broker and/or intermediary organizations in the preparation of the manuscript (false authorship);

3.3.4. adhere to the ethical principles of scholarly publishing as set forth in the journal's editorial policy.

3.4. The Author shall have the right to:

3.4.1. respectful and professional treatment by the journal editorial office and the Company's employees;

3.4.2. receive all necessary information regarding the status and progress of the manuscript through electronic information systems;

3.4.3. withdraw the manuscript at any stage of its consideration.

4. Fees and Payment Procedure

4.1. The Company has approved a price list for other paid services of the Non-Profit Joint-Stock Company "L.N. Gumilyov Eurasian National University."

4.1.1. Manuscript Registration and Submission

Upon registration and submission of a manuscript through the journal's electronic system, the Author shall pay a fee equal to 20% of the article publication fee (KZT 12,000).

This fee is intended to cover the Publisher's expenses, including:

- use of licensed plagiarism detection systems;
- remuneration of peer reviewers;
- editorial processing and administrative work of the journal.

In the event the manuscript is rejected by the journal editorial board, the above-mentioned fee shall be non-refundable.

4.1.2. Resubmission of the Manuscript

In the event of resubmission of the manuscript following revisions based on the results of the assessment for compliance with the journal's formal requirements and/or peer review, the Author shall be required to pay again a fee equal to 20% of the article publication fee (KZT 12,000).

- only one resubmission of the manuscript is permitted;
- in the event of a second rejection, no further consideration of the manuscript shall be undertaken.

4.1.3. Acceptance of the Article for Publication

The publication fee for one article accepted for publication by the journal editorial board shall be KZT 60,000 (sixty thousand Kazakhstani tenge).

Payment of the said amount shall be made after receipt of an official notification from the journal editorial office confirming acceptance of the article for publication.

4.1.4. Publication of the Article

Upon receipt of the full payment, the article shall be published in the relevant issue of the journal in accordance with the publication schedule.

4.2. The targeted use of the received funds shall be subject to monitoring by the Company.

5. Liability of the Parties

5.1. In the event of non-performance or improper performance of their obligations under this Agreement, the Parties shall bear liability in accordance with the applicable legislation of the Republic of Kazakhstan.

5.2. In the absence of feedback from the Author within one month (30 calendar days) following the reviewers' and/or journal editorial comments, or in the event of non-payment within 30 calendar days, this Agreement shall be deemed terminated.

5.3. The journal editorial office shall have the right to refuse publication of the article if it contains information that does not comply with the principles of scientific and/or publication ethics, academic integrity, or any other information that violates the legislation of the Republic of Kazakhstan.

6. Dispute Resolution Procedure

6.1. Any disagreements or disputes arising in the course of manuscript consideration shall be reviewed and resolved through mutual agreement of the Parties.

6.2. Disputes not resolved by mutual agreement shall be settled in accordance with the applicable legislation of the Republic of Kazakhstan.

7. Term and Effectiveness of the Agreement; Amendment and Termination

7.1. This Agreement shall enter into force upon acceptance, namely on the date of manuscript registration, and shall remain in effect until the publication of the article on the journal's website.

7.2. This Agreement shall remain valid in the event of changes to the details of the Parties, changes in their organizational and legal form, or in other similar circumstances.
